The Woman's City Club of Greater Cincinnati established the WCC & Marian A. Spencer Education Awards to encourage responsible civic awareness among local high school seniors who identify as female. The \$1000 education awards are presented directly to winning students to be used as needed to further their educational goals (college or post-secondary training).

The awards will be presented at a luncheon to be held on **Saturday, May 3 at the Kennedy Heights Arts Center Annex, Montgomery Road, Cincinnati.** Award recipients will be notified approximately two weeks prior to the event.

2025 ESSAY TOPIC

With the WCC mission in mind, address your ideas about: "Growing into Citizenship: Speaking Up and Making a Difference."

CONTEST REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. A full one-page essay on the 2025 topic. Essays should give examples of the applicant's relevant school activities and community involvement and demonstrate her understanding of the topic.
- 2. Applicant information form must be completed in full, including signatures from student and parent/guardian.
- 3. One signed letter of recommendation from counselor, teacher or administrator must be included.
- 4. Only complete applications with all required information sent together with the student's name on each page will be considered. **Deadline: no later than noon on Monday, April 7.**
